These seminars are presented by Grand Master and Master instructor's who have devoted their entire lives to the preservation of traditional and quality martial arts. The opportunity to learn and share knowledge with these individuals is truly a unique and rare experience for any martial arts enthusiast.

Kicking Seminar—Lead instructor Grand Master David J. Praim

- Approximately 2.5 hours
- Covers all types of basic kicks using the “4 Ss” to “close the gap.”

Free Sparring Seminar—Lead instructor Grand Master David J. Praim

- Approximately 2.5 hours
- Covers basic sparring and various sparring drills.

Self Defense Seminar for Unarmed Assailants—Lead instructor Grand Master David Swartz

- 2 or 4 hour seminars are offered
- Covers latest strategies against unarmed, single and multiple attackers, Michigan laws for various assaults, awareness, latest scams and more.

Self Defense Seminar for Armed Assailants—Lead instructor Grand Master David Swartz

- 2 or 4 hour seminars are offered
- Covers latest strategies against armed attackers with fire arms, knives and clubs. Includes defending, disarming and the use of the weapon to subdue the assailant with nonlethal force.

Forms Seminar—Lead instructor Master Ed Cutlip

- Approximately 2.5 hours
- Covers traditional tang soo do forms appropriate for the participants.

Jodo / Jojutsu Seminar—Lead instructor Master Kirk Rehn

- Approximately 2.5 hours
- Covers the use of a 4 foot staff which is relatively simple to learn, innocent looking and legal to carry. Will cover fundamental grips, postures, strikes, blocks, and self defense engagements. Advanced practioners will have the opportunity to learn the basics and kata of the All Japan Kendo Federation.
